Appendix 1

Trauma Informed Approaches

It is now recognised that experiences of adversity and trauma has the potential to affect the quality of a person's life, in particular, if events occurred during childhood. Children who experience adversity and trauma are more likely in adulthood, to experience poor physical and mental health, use substances, be involved with criminal justice. Traumatic experiences also occur in adulthood which can include domestic abuse, sexual assault and accidents. These difficulties can be compounded if individuals do not have access to appropriate services.

Everyone has a role to play in improving and shaping services to respond to the needs of survivors of trauma and abuse and be able to have the appropriate tools to make that difference. But we also need to take care of the workforce providing those services to ensure staff are fully supported and avoid burnout. Nobody needs to be an expert in trauma, but everyone should have the confidence in their role to broach the subject of trauma and abuse.

To ensure all services deliver a Recovery Oriented System of care (ROSC), the Scottish Government's Rights, Respect and Recovery Strategy and the Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) Standards for Scotland are committed to ensure that drug and alcohol treatment services have trauma informed approaches built into all policy and procedures.

The evidence-based NHS National Education Scotland Transforming Psychological Trauma Framework and Training Plan <u>trauma-training-plan-final.pdf</u> (<u>transformingpsychologicaltrauma.scot</u>) offers guidance to further support organisation managers and supervisors to identify the training needs of staff and help to develop a trauma informed workforce using existing skills and knowledge and evidenced based training to meet any identified gaps. The 'Taking a Trauma Informed Lens to your Organisation' (TICPOT) audit tool and Scottish Trauma Toolkit can also be useful as a way to start thinking about developing the trauma focused approach.
