Staying Alive - Preventing Drug-related Deaths

Overview

This course will discuss how services and practitioners can better prevent drug related deaths. This course will have particular focus on identifying the needs and risks of older people aged 35 years and over who use substances.

Learning Outcomes

By the end of the course participants will:

- Identify individual risk factors and high risk times for drug related death.
- Identify ways to engage and retain people in services.
- Identify good practice to reduce drug related death.

Course Length and Format

This course consists of 3.5 hours learning using the following format:

Part 1: SDF Overdose Prevention, Intervention and Naloxone e-learning module (1hr).
